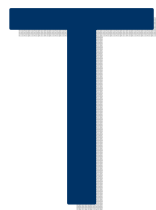

4. Important Next Steps



The very step taken to develop a CDS unleashes developmental energy. On agreement of the basic intent and approach taken in the CDS, the Municipality as custodian of the strategy, has to take concrete steps towards realising the broad plan.

In broad terms the Municipality has to take the following steps in moving the CDS forward:

- a) Formalising a forum of social partners;
- b) Initiating a series of bi-lateral meetings with key stakeholders;
- c) Conduct process of popularising and community engagement on BCDS;
- d) Entering in to creative partnerships through which to seal cooperation and commitment;
- e) Enter into a process of joint programme development – the very purpose of partnership development;
- f) Enable alignment of municipal institutional structures to BCDS objectives
- g) Translate BCDS into 5-year programme of implementation and review; and
- h) Exploring resources for the implementation of municipal BCDS initiatives.
