- Source: Integrated Coastal Management Plan
 - Nahoon Point Reserve
 - Nahoon Estuary Reserve
 - Waste Minimisation Project, 4 sites identified in East London CBD, Beacon Bay, King Williams Town and Mdantsane
- Source: Willie Maritz – Social Services
 - Planned development – Echo Camp development with overnight huts, fly fishing.
- Source: Mark Roebert – Social Service: Arts & Culture
 - Integration of booking system for all halls
 - New satellite library project at Dimbaza opening in next 6 months
- Source: Gerry Pienaar – Economic Affairs, Environment and Tourism
 - MK veterans want to establish a model gorilla camp, possibly in the Umtiza Nature Reserve
 - Two applications to establish community nature reserves at Nkega & Kiwani (Jam Jam)
 - Eco lodge at Chilumna with boat launch site and accommodation. Funded through poverty relief.
 - Tyolomnqa bride rest stop planned.

 - Fort Grey – existing campsite is under utilised. Cultural village could be developed and a tourist train could be developed between Fort Grey and Fort Pato

 - Rooikrantz area has an existing conference facility and the development of overnight accommodation have been proposed
 - Department want to develop agri landscape project to utilise organic farming that is landscaped to serve as tourist attraction
