In an attempt to Make A Difference on the issue of refuse collection, the Acting Municipal manager Dr Lulama Zitha this morning read the riot act to service providers responsible for this in the City.

This follows reports that refuse in the Mdantsane area was not collected earlier this week.

The meeting was also attended by Community Services management members who were also not spared.

Dr Zitha reminded the service providers – Sisonke, Mdantsane refuse Collectors and Millennium Waste Management – that the Municipality was prepared to undertake all the necessary processes to ensure that BCM consumers got the services that they deserve.

She pointed out that their performance was linked to a contract that is part of an agreement between them and the Municipality.

“We will not tolerate under performance and we will use the performance clauses that are in the contract to terminate agreements if needs be,” Dr Zitha said.
