The **BUFFALO CITY MUNICIPALITY** invites tenders for four alternatives for the construction, completion and defects liability period maintenance, of a black top surfaced dual carriage way primary distributor urban road some 1,25km in length, including two traffic circles, one major intersection and two minor intersections as an extension of an existing road, the construction of two black top single carriage way link roads, 1,04km long, between the end road and existing urban streets, including street lighting, pedestrian walkways, cycle paths, relocation of services, installation of a main water line and installation of a power supplying ring feed cable. Prospective tenderers are required to submit a tender offer for each of the four alternatives described in Part C3 : Scope of Work of the tender document.

TENDERERS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE CIDB IN CE CLASS OF CONSTRUCTION WORKS, AD BE GRADED AT LEAST AT LEVEL 8, OR EQUIVALENT THERETO IN THE CONTRACTOR GRADING CATEGORY.

Preferences are offered to tenderers who tender in terms of the Buffalo City Municipality's Preferential Procurement Policy (90/10). The points allocation will be stipulated in the tender document.

Preferences are offered to tenderers who tender contract participation goals in terms of :

- SANS 1914-1:2002 in respect of targeted enterprises
- SANS 1914-5:2002 in respect of targeted labour

One set of tender documents may be obtained from the Directorate of Engineering Services, Room 500 on the 5th Floor of the Buffalo City Municipal offices in 26 Oxford Street, East London (phone 043-7059111), upon payment of the required document fee of R400,00 payable in cash or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the Buffalo City Municipality as from Monday, 16 July 2007. Additional copies may be obtained for the fee indicated above. These fees will not be refunded.

All tenderers are required to ensure a suitable representative attends the compulsory clarification meeting, at which representatives of the Buffalo City Municipality will be present. All tenderers will be required to sign the attendance register. Failure to attend this meeting shall result in the tender being declared non-response. The **Compulsory** clarification meeting will take place at Beacon Bay Library, Sherwood Avenue, Big Hall on **Friday, 20 July 2007**, starting at **10:00**.

SUBMISSION OF TENDERS:

Tenders must be submitted before 12:00 on Friday, 10 August 2007.

Tenders may be submitted by hand, by post. Faxed, e-mailed, postal, telegraphic, unsigned or incomplete tenders will not be accepted.

1. **By hand** : Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with the Tenderer's name and address and the contract number must be deposited in the formal tender box, Main Payments Hall, Munifin Centre, Caxton Street, East London or the Town Secretary's Department, Civic Centre, Independence Avenue, Bisho.

It must be expressly understood that the Council disclaims any responsibility for seeing that tenders sent by post or delivered in any other way to the council, are lodged in the Tender Box. It is accordingly preferable for the tenderer to personally ensure that the tender is placed in the Tender Box by the tenderer's own staff, or where appropriate, a courier appointed by the tenderer.

OPENING OF TENDERS:

Tenders will be opened in public at 14:00 on Friday, 10 August 2007, Room 212, Munifin Centre, 29 Oxford Street, East London.

Standard tender conditions will apply. Council reserves the right not to accept the only or lowest or any tender at all, or to accept the whole or part of any tender. The invitation and award of tenders is not subject to the Buffalo Council's Procurement Policy on tenders.

The Council reserves the right to extend the tender period by a notice in the press.
