Contract ED 320: Removal of existing and design and installation of new street lighting on the Esplanade.	Monday, 3 September 2007 at 10.00, Beacon Bay Municipal offices, Corner of Major Square and Sherwood Avenue and will be required to sign attendance register.

Scope: The proposal shall encompass the removal of the existing streetlighting, design supply of a new decorative installation on the Esplanade which is a tourist focal point of BCM (From the Orient Theatre, Currie Street to Moore Street).

- The pole luminaire combination (Road frontage and walkway) shall be of an extraordinary decorative design.
- Wherever possible the existing mounting positions shall be used as to prevent the unnecessary disturbance of existing roads and walkways.
- The material shall be suited for the harsh coastal environment and all efforts must be made to make these poles and luminaires as maintenance free as possible.
- The lighting levels shall be in accordance with the lighting levels, as required by the SANS Code: SANS 10090: Lighting of Public Thoroughfares. The design is to be based on Class A2 road way.
- It shall be suitable to attached Christmas Decorations over the festive season. Therefore the mechanical design shall be suited for this task. (to attach catenary wire and festival features.)
- The luminaires shall provide white, un-obstructive lighting which shall prevent light pollution and interference for the residential property's along the Esplanade. The system shall be able to operate as energy efficient as possible.
- The proposed contractor shall have the relevant CIBD rating and shall comply with all BCM requirements.

The proposal shall consist of the following:

- Proposed lighting lay-out,
- Detailed calculations, proofing the compliance to Class A2 Road Lighting,
- Pictures of the proposed lighting column,
- Pictures of the proposed fittings,
- Datasheet of proposed luminaire,

- Datasheet of proposed light source,
- Specification of the proposed pole and its surface treatment
- Bill of Quantities with pricing.
- Full project programme (Delivery & installation period)

Adjudication Criteria

The following criteria will be used in the adjudication of the proposal:

- a) Points for price (60 points)
- b) Points for meeting BCM requirements (20 points).
- c) Points for Aesthetics (10 points)
- d) HDI points (10 points)
 - 3 points PDI
 - 1 point women
 - 1 point disabled
 - 2 points local supplier
 - 3 points local contractor

Note:

Contractors are advised to attend the **compulsory site** meeting and will be required to sign the attendance register. Failure to attend this meeting shall result in the rejection of the proposal.

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

Proposals must be submitted before 12:00 on Friday, 14 September 2007.

Proposals may be submitted by hand only. Telegraphic, Postal, Faxed or e-mailed tenders will not be accepted.

By hand : Sealed proposals endorsed "**Proposals for removal of existing and design and installation of new street lighting on the Esplanade**" on the envelope with the Tenderer's name and address and the contract number must be deposited in the formal tender box, Main Payments Hall, Munifin Centre, Caxton Street, East London or the Town Secretary's Department, Civic Centre, Independence Avenue, Bisho.

It must be expressly understood that the City Council disclaims any responsibility for seeing that tenders sent or delivered in any other way to the Council, are lodged in the Tender Box. It is accordingly preferable for the Tenderer to personally ensure that the tender is placed in the Tender Box by the Tenderer's own staff, or where appropriate a courier appointed by the Tenderer.

OPENING OF PROPOSAL

Proposal will be opened in public at 14:00 on Friday, 14 September 2007, Room 212, Munifin Centre, 29 Oxford Street, East London.

The invitation and award of proposal is subject to the Council's Procurement Policy on tenders.

The Municipality is not bound to accept any tender, or to furnish any reasons for the acceptance or rejection of a tender.

Canvassing of Councillors or Municipal Officials shall disqualify a tender.

The Council reserves the right to extend the tender period by a notice in the press.
