REPORT TO THE CITY MANAGER ON THE HALF YEAR FINANCIAL PERFROMANCE AND POSITION OF THE AGENCY

1. PURPOSE

To report to the Parent Municipality on the financial performance and position of the Agency for the period 01 July 2020 to 31 December 2020.

2. BACKGROUND

The Accounting Officer of a municipal entity must by 20 January of each year:

- a) assess the performance of the entity during the first half of the financial year, taking into account:
 - i.the monthly statements referred to in section 87 for the first half of the financial year and the targets set in the service delivery, business plan or other agreement with the entity's parent municipality; and
 - ii.the entity's annual report for the past year, and progress on resolving problems identified in the annual report; and
- b) submit a report on such assessment to –
 i.the board of directors of the entity; and
 - ii. the parent municipality of the entity

3.1 Financial performance

- a) To date the Agency achieved 87 % of its year-to- date budget allocation as the variance percentage is 13 %. The actual amount invoiced for the operating grant during the period under review amounted to R 23 080 246 due to an agreement reached of invoicing two tranches in a financial year. The 1st tranche allocation of the BCMM operational grant got reduced by the output VAT of R 3 010 467 as the municipal entity is a registered VAT vendor.
- b) BCMM Operational Grant for capital projects has a -166% variance. The amount received to date is equivalent to the expenditure incurred as at 31 December 2020. The revenue recognised will increase in the same proportion as expenditure incurred as this grant is recognised on a claim basis from the City. The variance is as a result of a reduced capital allocation which subsequently got adjusted to R 50 million and a roll-over of R43.9 million from the preceding financial year after the budget was approved and that will be appropriately adjusted in the adjustments budget.
- LGSETA grant is received based on trainings attended and paid for of which there
 has been a decline in that due to the national lockdown.
- d) DEFF waste management is more than anticipated due to extension of contracts to the 19th of February 2021 and the procurement of bulk purchases e.g refuse bags and work suits.
- e) Developments levy fees have not yet been received as the lease agreements were recently concluded.
- f) Interest received variance is 45% of the budgeted amount. This is as a result of interest earned on the money market and the primary bank accounts. The Agency anticipated to receive the BCMM Capital grant in advance so as to invest it in order to increase the internally generated revenue however that was not feasible as the

- City has advised that the capital grant disbursement will be on a claim basis for construction work done.
- g) The agency fees are more than anticipated due to contractors and consultants' fees based on the work done.
- h) Other income mainly relates to tender document fees wherein none were sold as all tender documents were requested electronically.

- a) The Operational Expenditure has a variance of 20% which is as a result of the following:
 - General expenditure has a -31% variance due to contractors' fees which are
 more that the budget amount as the roll-over of funds from the preceding year
 and adjusted budget allocation was approved after the budget was concluded.
 For other major projects procurement processes are underway.
 - DEFF project expenditure has a -113% variance due to a change in the business plan which led to the project workers' contracts being extended to 19 February 2021 after it was resolved that certain deliverables will no longer be executed. The budget will therefore be adjusted to accommodate the changes during the adjustments budget process.

 The variance of 22% on employee related costs is due to three vacancies which have not yet been filled, leave provision, performance bonuses which have not yet been paid and the Agency will adjust its budget for the current financial year.

3.2 Financial position

3.2.1 Assets

The agency has incurred expenditure on procurement of computer equipment and office furniture. (Annexure A- Asset Management) report on the status of asset management of the Agency.

3.2.2 Liabilities

- a) The Act requires that all creditors be settled within 30 days of receipt of invoice from a supplier/service provider. All creditors were paid within 30 days from the date of receiving an invoice.
- b) As at the end of the period under review, Trade and Other payables relate to a trade creditor error to be resolved by the system vendor, unspent conditional grant, leave provision, retention costs for capital projects, a provision for repairing the previous office building and lease liabilities.

1. Introduction

The Supply Chain Management (SCM) policy of the Agency and the Local Government: Municipal Supply Management (SCM) Regulations state under paragraph 16(3) that the Accounting Officer must report to the Board of Directors, on the implementation of the SCM policy.

When fulfilling its procurement objectives, the Agency must comply with the SCM Regulations and its Supply Chain Management Policy.

The Municipal Finance Management Act states that the Accounting Officer is responsible for managing the financial administration of the municipal entity and must for this purpose take all reasonable steps to ensure that the resources of the municipal entity are used effectively, efficiently and economically.

1.1 Purpose

To report on the implementation of the Agency's Supply Chain Management Policy for the period 01 July 2020 to 31 December 2020.

1.2 Legislative Framework

The Municipal Finance Management Act No. 56 of 2003 (MFMA), Chapter 11 Local Government: Municipal Supply Management (SCM) Regulations of 2005 Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000 (PPPFA) Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 Supply Chain Management Policy

2. SCM Policy & Procedures

2.1 Adoption of Policy by Board

The revised SCM Policy was approved by Board in August 2018. The policy is under revision and has been tabled at the Organisational Committee for consideration.

2.2 SCM Procedures

Standard operating procedures are in place and were adopted by the Agency's Executive Management.

2.3 Delegations

SCM Process Delegations are stipulated in the approved SCM Policy and are adhered to.

2.4 Infrastructure Procurement

The Agency has not yet adopted the Standard for Infrastructure Procurement and Delivery Management as it is still at consultation stage nationally.

3. Functioning of the SCM Unit

3.1 SCM Structure:

As at 31 December 2020 the SCM Unit consists of the following personnel:

- Manager: SCM and Asset Management who reports to the CFO;
- SCM and Asset Practitioner who reports Manager: SCM and Asset Management;
- Finance Intern assigned to the SCM Unit.

3.2 Declaration of Interest:

Along with all other Agency personnel, the SCM Personnel declare their interests annually. With regards to bid committee meetings, all members complete declaration of interest form for each sitting.

3.3 Training of SCM Personnel:

The Finance Intern assigned to the SCM Unit has registered with Fort Hare Trading Solutions (Pty) Ltd for the Municipal Finance Management Programme. Training of bid committee members is scheduled to take place in February 2021.
