Mentor Programme

Buffalo City Metropolitan Municipality jointly with National Treasury hereby invites Qualified Registered Mentors to assist with mentoring of young technical graduates.

The objective of this programme is to make provision for Qualified Mentors who will assist and train all the graduates in their respective fields to meet requirements in order to register with professional bodies within a period of three years.

The program is designed to assist participants with practical experience in their field of qualification and further engage them in gaining experience in the workplace.

Mentor Salary (rates will be a per DPSA hourly rates for consultants)

The contracts will be for a period of one (1) year

MENTOR: TOWN PLANNING

Requirements:

- B Tech or any other appropriate Degree in Town & Regional Planning as prescribed and recognised by the South African Council for Town Planning (SACPLAN) in terms of the Planning Profession Act, 2002 (Act 36 of 2002)
- Valid code B/EB drivers licence
- Must be registered as a Technical/Professional Planner with SACPLAN
- Computer literate
- Five (5) years' post professional registration working experience in Land Use Management, Spatial Planning and Settlement Planning

MENTOR: GIS

- Be a PLATO registered Professional GIS Practitioner
- Minimum of 5 years relevant post registration work experience
- Preference should be given to someone with mentoring experience (but not to disqualify a suitable candidate without mentoring experience)
- He must provide guidance in regard to academic training in line with accredited and appropriate education programme for which the Council has granted recognition in terms of section 13 (4))(a), (b),(c), or (d)of the Geomatics Profession Act (Act No. 19 of 2013).
- The mentor must develop the academic framework for the assessment of the interns in compliance with the legislation and regulations of the National Qualifications Framework Act (Act 67 of 2008), and the South African Qualifications Authority
- The period of training needs to be specified in accordance with the Act

MENTOR: ELECTRICAL

Requirements:

- Registered Electrical Engineer (Pr.Eng/Pr.Tech.Eng)
- Category (Distribution/Industrial)
- Computer Literate
- Valid Code B/EB Drivers Licence
- Ability to train and mentor new graduates.

MENTOR: QUANTITY SURVEYOR

Requirements:

- A relevant degree in Quantity Surveying
- Must be registered as a Professional Quantity Surveyor in good standing with SACQSP
- Must have five (5) years working experience post professional registration
- Valid code B/EB drivers licence

Preference will be given to applicants who have proven experience in the following:

- Mentoring of Candidate Quantity Surveyors
- Presenting Quantity Surveying Training Modules related to professional registration
- Computer Literate

MENTOR: PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR

Requirements:

- M+4 BSc. Degree in Land Surveying/Geomatics.
- Must be registered as a Professional Land Surveyor in good standing with South African Geomatics Council (SAGC), previously known as South African Council for Professional and Technical Surveyors – (PLATO)
- Must have five (5) years working experience post professional registration
- Valid code B/EB drivers licence
- Computer Literate
